Living Wills or Advance Decisions A living will or Advance decisions in the UK and Wales (Advance Directive in Scotland), otherwise called an Advance Care Plan is a non-legal document which stipulates, for example, whether you want to be resuscitated, or should you become seriously ill, what life-prolonging treatment you might wish for, or who you would like to be informed. Advance decisions (living wills) An advance decision allows you to express your wishes to refuse medical treatment in future. It is sometimes referred to as a living will.
