WHEN A RESERVE MACHINE IS AVAILABLE The precinct election officers should direct voters to vote on the electronic accessible voting machine in the precinct. A challenge to your voting qualifications are approved by the Precinct Captain. Your right to vote was challenged by another voter or a poll watcher and approved by the Precinct Captain. Your Special Ballot will be counted if the Board determines that you are the person you say you are and you are eligible to vote in the election.
