The Honda CB125 is a 122 cc (7.4 cu in) motorcycle made by Honda from 1971–1975 (1973–1985 in the US). It had an overhead camshaft (OHC) engine with a 9500 rpm redline. The "S" model was produced from 1971 to 1975 and was replaced in 1976 by the "J" model (the US bikes retained the S designation).
