To cite a television show for social science research, you will often need to use American Psychological Association, or APA, style, which can be found in the sixth edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association. You can cite a single episode of a television show or an entire television series. After the name of the sixth author, write three ellipsis points followed by the last author's name. APA radio and television citation is almost similar with how you cite a book. This part will show you the elements, guides and formats in writing in-text citation and reference list, as well as specific examples. Begin with the title of the episode in quotation marks. Provide the name of the series or program in italics. Also include the network name, call letters of the station followed by the city, and the date of broadcast. End with the publication medium (e.g. Television, Radio). How to Write the Title of a TV Show Using APA. The format of the title of a work depends on the section of your paper and whether the work stands alone or is part of a greater whole, according to the sixth edition of the Publication Manual of the American Psychological Association.
