These tasks include monitoring a patient's health, measuring vital signs, tracking medical history, administer medications, perform treatments, changing bandages, helping patients ...LPNs who wish to advance their careers enroll in LPN to RN (or LVN to RN) bridge programs, which can be taken in-person or online. Both on-campus and online LPN to RN programs prepare students for RN licensure by completing an associate degree in nursing.
